October Gardening Tips:

- Cut and dry perennials for flower arranging.
- Weed, shape, and edge beds.
- Mark spots where perennials are located
- Bring houseplants inside after you examine and debug.
- Divide and move crowded perennials.
- Mulch with chopped leaves.
- Begin bulb planting after first frost.
- Provide suet, water and housing for birds.
