November Gardening Tips:

- Keep leaves off lawn to prevent smothering grass.
- Leaves can be added to your compost pile or used as a mulch
- Start or continue a log of the season's successes and failures.
- Plant new spring bulbs and pansies.
- Feed established bulbs with a balance slow-release fertilizer (9-9-6), bone meal is good for bulbs
- Feed acid loving plants (dogwood, azaleas, hollies) with Hollytone
- At 50 degrees all house plants outside should be debugged and brought back into the house
- Plant an Amaryllis inside for their beauty at Christmas
- Clean and oil garden tools to protect them over the winter.
- Empty, clean and store plant containers in a protected area.
